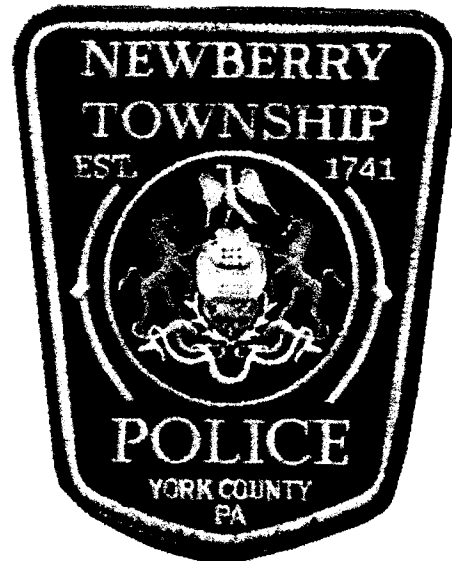

Supervisors and Staff,

The department handled 888 calls for the month of February 2017. Listing the calls by criteria, 0 rape, 0 robberies, 2 aggravated assaults, 1 burglaries, 14 thefts, 6 drug offenses. 15 DUI's, 4 Simple Assaults, 2 Sexual Assault, 7 Domestic related harassments, and 11 other harassments. Officers investigated 13 domestic incidents, 361 other calls for service, investigated 19 traffic accidents, issued 134 traffic citations, 250 traffic warnings, and issued 14 non-traffic citations.

I would like to commend the efforts of the criminal investigative support unit consisting of Lieutenant Steven Luts, Detective Daniel Grimme and Detective Kevin Romine. They were successful in apprehending the group of skimming suspects that were stealing money from victims that had their bank information compromised at our local Rutters stores. These suspects were involved in a large scaled fraud operation where debit and credit card information was being stolen and cash withdrawn from ATM machines. They are all awaiting court dates and incarcerated.
