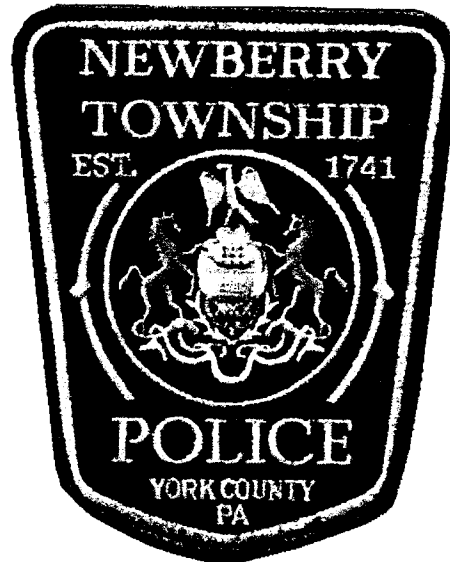

Supervisors and Staff,

The department handled 731 calls for the month of June 2018. Listing the calls by criteria, 3 Aggravated Assaults, 1 Burglaries, 19 Thefts, 1 Theft of a Motor Vehicle, 12 drug offenses, 8 DUI's, 2 Simple Assaults, 3 Sexual Assaults, 4 Domestic related harassments, and 8 other harassments. Additionally, officers responded to and investigated 375 other calls for service including 37 domestic related incidents and 18 traffic accidents. They issued 71 traffic citations, 129 traffic warnings, issued 9 non-traffic citations, and made 24 misdemeanor/ felony criminal arrests.

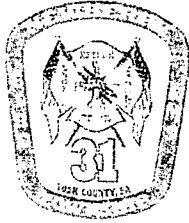
