Continuing to gather the trash at all the parks.

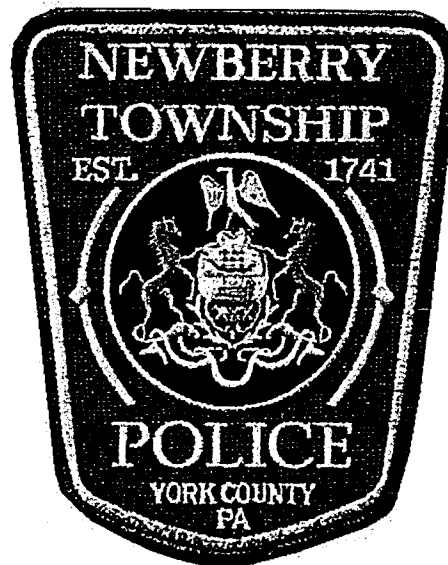

Supervisors and Staff,

The department handled 734 calls for the month of October 2018. Listing the calls by criteria, 1 Robbery, 4 Burglaries, 8 thefts, 9 drug offenses, 14 DUI's, 3 Simple Assaults, 3 Sexual Assaults, 13 Domestic related harassments, 8 other harassments, and 28 other offenses. Additionally, officers responded to and investigated 374 other calls for service including 33 domestic related incidents and 24 traffic accidents. They issued 82 traffic citations, 130 traffic warnings, issued 9 non-traffic citations, and made 26 misdemeanor/ felony criminal arrests.
