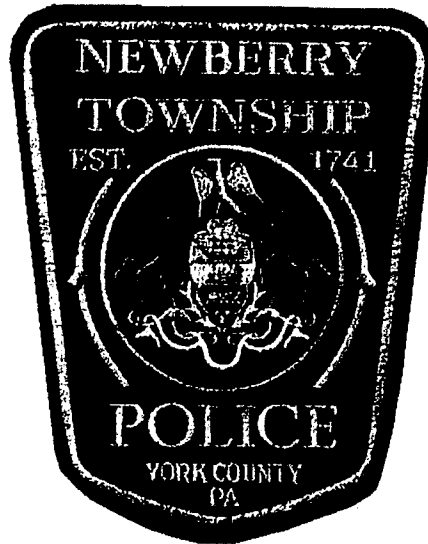

Supervisors and Staff,

The department handled 1069 calls for the month of July 2021. Listing calls by criteria: 2 Aggravated Assaults, 7 Burglaries, 12 Thefts, 2 Motor Vehicle Theft, 2 Drug Offenses, 16 DUI's, 7 Simple Assaults, 3 Sexual Assaults, 2 other Harassments, and 27 all other offenses. Additionally, officers responded to and investigated 989 other calls for service including 19 Domestic related incidents and 17 traffic accidents. They issued 49 traffic citations, 102 warnings, issued 9 non-traffic citations and made 44 misdemeanor/felony criminal arrests.

Current Work:

Fixing inlets that are coming apart, parging pipes so they stop sinking beside the boxes.

Continuing MS4 inlet inspections for the year doing Zone 1 this year.

Mowing along the roadways to keep growth back where needed.

Working on keeping the ball fields groomed.

Stock piling fill dirt for land behind highway shop.

Removed more stumps and brush, stripped topsoil. Moved a pile of fill dirt over the bank so we can build upon it and make more room for more.

Cleaning up after Ida, cleaning debris off and from under all the bridges, repairing washouts around the bridges. Repairing washouts along road ditches, sink holes around pipes. Placing rock in washouts where it is deep enough to hold the large rock.

Removing woody debris from ditch lines and around bridges, surprisingly there is not a lot clogged up in the bridges, only a few spots that we will need to have a track hoe with a thumb to remove the trees.

FIELD AND PLANT REPORT

- Continue plant and pump station operations, maintenance and repairs.
- Replacing Anodes for Cathodic protection of both steel Digester tanks.
- Goodman warehouse #1, Lexington Ph IV, Woods Ph III, 105 Newberry Parkway installing sewer and punchlist items remain.
- Planning plumbing and guide rail rehab at Ridgeview Pump Station.
- IDA Storm Damage: Main pump station was flooded and out of service, rented temporary bypass pumping to handle the flow until pump station was operational. Evaluating equipment damage and repairing and/or replacing as needed. Met with EMA, FEMA, and twp. manager at wastewater plant to observe the damaged facility and discuss mitigation and reimbursement options.

**Newberry Township Monthly Manager's Report
Board of Supervisors meeting
Tuesday September 28, 2021**

Township Business:

- Application for On Road Rebate Truck Replacement program with DEP is currently under review by DEP/DCED. This can potentially provide vouchers for 70% of the cost to replace the three trucks that are in need or replacement from our fleet. A \$168,000 savings which is the total cost of two trucks. E.g., we could get three trucks for the cost of one.
- Dolan Park Rehab grant status still under review by DCED. (\$250,000)
- Destruction of old records ongoing per the resolution.
- Codification ongoing with General Code awaiting final draft.
- QuickBooks upgrade in process for both General Accounting and Sewer Accounting. This will give the ability to also upgrade to Point of Sale (POS) applications and discontinue cash register technology.
- The land that was in the little league lease has been surveyed.
- Continue to receive multiple Right to Know requests and multiple Office of Open Records appeals by Andrew Popp.
- Ongoing design and planning for Multi-use Emergency Services Building
- Engaged with our grant writer for multiple grants associated with the MESB, including RACP, facility grants for Generator, sewer and water, and Audio-Visual systems. She is also working towards authorization for a FEMA disaster site and PEMA disaster site for the complex.
- Sourced EMS providers for interim EMS services agreement effective October 1, 2021 as a result of Newberry Fire and EMS notification to end services September 30, 2021.
- Documenting and Reporting damages and costs associated with Hurricane IDA to PEMA and FEMA.

SewerAdministration

- On September 1, Gayle sent out 141 courtesy letters to customers informing them that they had missed payments for two quarters. (\$46,500 outstanding) The next billing cycle will put them over the \$400.00 threshold that initiates the water shut off/sewer plug process. To date, 60 (\$19,450) customers have paid in full. We received \$1700.00 from GH Harris and Gayle has begun to take some of those accounts back for collections by the township. "Courtesy Letters" are sent out 4 times a year to residents to keep all accounts under the \$400.00 threshold that would lead to a water shut off/sewer plug process. The previous sewer shut off process was in August and all accounts were paid and no shut off occurred.

- Since the spending guidance for the distribution of funds under the American Rescue Plan Act have not been totally defined, the receipt of the first half award of the funds under the American Rescue Plan Act remain on deposit.
- All insurance policies with a September 1 expiration have been renewed.
- The first draft of the 2022 budget will be discussed at the mid-October BOS meeting.
- The Township is applying for grant monies through FEMA to recover clean-up expense incurred from hurricane Ida.
